Description

The 2JFX8 Protective Ceiling Fan guard is designed to protect Ceiling Fans from contact with large foreign objects. The guard mounts to the ceiling so that extra weight load is not distributed to the down rod of the ceiling fan assembly or its fixture. The heavy duty wire frame construction makes it ideal for gymnasiums, indoor tennis or sport arenas.

▲ CAUTION guard weight Since the fan and exceed 35 lbs., box and installation must comply with NED code ART-422-13. The guard cannot be supported from

the fan downrod. The downrod should only be used to align guard and prevent excess movement.

NOTE: Install ceiling fan per instructions supplied in box.

Installation

Each fan guard (Model 2JFX8) consists of (4) each top and bottom quarter sections, (28) wire clips, (4) S-hooks, wire chain and a strap clamp.

1. Install (4) support chains 90° apart on 30 inch radius (see Figure 1).

- 2. Assemble (2) sections of top guard together with (3) wire clips. Assemble other (2) sections together at same points.
- 3. Assemble the (2) half sections together with (6) wire clips (see Figure 2), and hang sections from chains with S-hooks through eyelets.

NOTE: The top section should be level and about 1 inch above the lower canopy.



4. Use strap clamp to clamp guard sections together at downrod (see Figure 3).







- 5. Hang bottom guard sections on top guard using eyes on top guard and hooks on bottom guard.
- 6. Attach (4) wire clips along each mating segment of bottom guard to secure sections (see Figure 4). After bottom quard sections are in place and all (16) clips are attached, close (12) S-hooks on both sides with pliers to secure guard assembly.
- 7. During and after assembly be sure blades are not bent. Blades must be in same plane to prevent wobble during operation.






Figure 5 - Repair Parts Illustration for Ceiling Fan Guard
